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- 1 All volunteers must be approved by the principal and shall serve under the supervision and direction of
- 2 the professional personnel of the school to which they are assigned. Volunteers shall assist professional
- 3 personnel in the performance of their teaching and administrative responsibilities. They may not teach,
- 4 but they may reinforce skills taught by the professional staff. In all cases, a responsible employee shall
- 5 retain the final authority over students, school programs, and services.
- 6 The principal shall identify appropriate tasks for volunteers and shall be responsible for planning and
- 7 conducting orientation programs and regular in-service training sessions.
- 8 While serving as a volunteer, no individual shall have access to any student's confidential medical or
- 9 educational records, including but not limited to doctors' notes, report cards, attendance records,
- 10 discipline records, and cumulative student records.
- Volunteers shall serve without compensation but shall be insured by the Board against loss or damage
- in the performance of their duties.<sup>1</sup>
- The Superintendent of Schools shall develop procedures to require the appropriate background checks
- 14 for volunteers.<sup>2</sup>
