# FAQ

1. **What if the camp is cancelled?** A refund will be issued.
2. **What time does the camp start?** 8:00 AM on Monday, June 14 at Centennial High School. When you arrive at CHS, enter the school through the main entrance and head straight back to the Media Center. Someone will be there to greet you and check you in. Camp will end at 3:00 PM.
3. **Who are the supervisors?** WCS Camp Supervisors are Tim Sawyer and Paula Chilton. These professionals will guide you on an adventure into a world of drafting, marketing, information technology, media, entrepreneurship, engineering, graphic design, law enforcement, as well as many others.
4. **What else do we need to know?** You will need to know the following:
  - **Camp Shirts:** Camp shirts will be provided and given to you on the day you arrive. Please wear your camp shirt for our field trips to other schools on Tuesday and Thursday.
  - **Lunch:** Lunch will be provided each day. If you require a special diet, please bring your own lunch each day.
  - **Transportation:** You need to provide your own transportation to and from Centennial High School each day.
  - **Friday:** Closing ceremonies will take place at Centennial High School in the Media Center. Students and parents should arrive at 8:00am.
  - **Dress Code:** Please follow appropriate school dress code Monday through Thursday. We will meet with business executives and professional educators each day; an appropriate appearance is required. Remember to dress for comfort and activity. Please dress professionally for closing ceremonies on Friday morning. The ceremony will take place at Centennial High School Media Center.
  - **Discipline:** You MUST follow Williamson County Schools behavior guidelines during Girls TEC Camp. Failure to adhere to WCS rules of behavior will initially result in a warning and parent(s) will be notified. If the student continues to be a disturbance, a parent or guardian will be called to pick up their student, and the student will no longer be allowed to participate in Girls TEC Camp any further and a refund will NOT be issued.
  - **Covid guidelines:** We will continue to follow the guidance of the CDC and the State Health Department and require students, staff, and visitors to wear cloth face coverings.
