

## <u>WILLIAMSON COUNTY SCHOOLS</u> RELIGIOUS EXEMPTION FROM VACCINATION(S) PER TCA§49-6-5001

In the absence of an epidemic or immediate threat of an epidemic, a student may attend school exempt from the legal requirement of proof of immunization if the parent or guardian submits a signed, written statement that immunizations conflict with the parent's or guardian's religious tenets and practices, affirmed under the penalties of perjury. Such perjury in Tennessee is a Class A Misdemeanor, carrying with it penalties which include up to 11 months, 29 days imprisonment and a \$2,500.00 fine. These penalties may change from time to time, and other penalties may apply.
