Job Overview

The job of the Math Tutor was established for the purpose of assisting students in providing focused interventions related to math using math strategies to individual students or small groups of students.

This job reports to the School Principal.

Essential Functions

- Holds/maintains a strong, relevant, and current understanding of all math concepts.
- Analyzes data and monitors student progress while delivering focused intervention/assistance to students.
- Demonstrates exemplary instructional practice and possesses a deep understanding of teaching and learning for the purpose of effective best practices to improve student achievement results and close achievement gaps; helps with homework.
- Provides a foundational level of math concepts to students.
- Maintains a variety of manual and electronic files and/or records (e.g. TCAP data, student records, and other data regarding proficiency) for the purpose of determining student needs.
- Prepares lesson plans, in collaboration with teachers and coaches, related to differentiating.

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Working Environment

This job is performed in a standard office environment and in a generally clean and healthy environment. Generally, the job requires 80% sitting, 10% walking, and 10% standing.

Physical Requirements: occasional lifting, carrying, pushing, and/or pulling; some stooping, kneeling, crouching, and/or crawling; and significant fine finger dexterity.
