Use a WCS Google Chrome Profile

It is important to be signed in to your child's WCS Google Chrome profile to ensure your child's ClassLink Dashboard works properly.

When using a shared family device^{*}, it may be helpful to create multiple Chrome profiles. This allows users to easily switch between profiles and keep all data (browsing history, searches, passwords, etc.) separate. This also alleviates issues with application access and ensures that the correct Google account is being used.

*If using a Chromebook, the user should sign out, and the new user should sign in to the device with their WCS Chrome profile.

Important Notes

- When using a shared device, each user should *always* verify they are using their unique Chrome profile.
- Signing into a WCS account (WCS Google profile) will track usage analytics and may apply restrictions.

Add a WCS Chrome Profile Open Google Chrome. Existing profiles will be displayed. To add a WCS Chrome profile, select Add. If you are already signed into a Chrome profile, use the instructions in the step below to add an additional profile.
