### Community

Williamson County is located just south of Nashville, Tennessee. Williamson County Schools serves over 40,000 students through 11 high schools, 10 middle schools, and 28 elementary schools. WCS students consistently earn test scores among the highest in the state.

### School

Centennial High School is nationally recognized as one of the **2023 Best High Schools** by *U.S. News & World Report*. It is a public, four-year comprehensive high school with 110 faculty members, a majority of whom have a master's degree or higher. The school day consists of seven 48- minute class periods. Most students enroll in six academic classes and one study hall. All classes meet 5 days per week for two 18-week semesters. Centennial High School's enrollment for 2025-2026 school year is 1307 students.

Prior to the 2025-26 school year, GPAs of transfer students were taken "as is" from their prior school, whether weighted or unweighted.
