Fairview has easy access to Nashville and is nestled within the scenic, historical Natchez Trace Parkway. Many families have resided in Fairview for generations, while more recently, the rural setting has attracted new families.</p> | <p>SCHOOL SYSTEM</p> <p>Williamson County Schools is a P-12 school district with approximately 41,000 students enrolled for the 2025-2026 school year. There are 54 school sites: 11 high schools, 12 middle schools, 29 elementary schools, one K-8 school and one alternative learning center.</p> |
| <p>SCHOOL INFORMATION</p> <p>Fairview High School has been in existence since 1956 and has been in its current location since 1982. In 2017 a new Performing Arts Center was built, new TV broadcast and theatre classrooms. A student qualifies for the HOPE Scholarship if an ACT score of 21/980 SAT or a 3.0 cumulative GPA (based on TN Uniform Grading Scale) is earned by the end of the 12th grade year.
