Williamson County Schools (WCS) is one of two public school districts located in Williamson County, Tennessee. WCS continues to be a leader in the State in academic achievement. WCS has approximately 41,750 students enrolled in Pre-K - 12 for the 2025-2026 school year. There are 53 schools: 11 high schools, 12 middle schools, 29 elementary schools, and one K-8 school. The district's graduating class of 2024 posted an ACT composite score of 25.2, which is well above the State's average composite score of 19.3. WCS ranks first in Tennessee among districts with more than one high school

The HOPE Scholarship GPA listed on the transcript is calculated using the TN Uniform Grading Scale. It is calculated for HOPE scholarship eligibility only.

Beginning with the 2025-26 school year, WCS began recalculating GPAs of transfer students using the WCS weighted scale to create a uniform Weighted Cumulative GPA for all WCS students. Prior to the 2025-26 school year, GPAs of transfer students were taken "as is" from their prior school, whether weighted or unweighted.

Williamson County Schools Board of Education policy 4.600: For the graduating class of 2020 and beyond: "Williamson County Schools will not rank students numerically."

The Average Policy for certain courses allows students to gain a full credit if they failed the first semester but passed the second semester and the average of the two semesters is a D or higher. This policy applies to the following courses: math, foreign language, chemistry and physics.

Credit recovery for courses failed fall 2017 and after is recorded on the transcript as "D".
