Addendum II is being distributed to all 3 approved vendors for WCS – RFP #1232 E-Rate Procurement.

Clarification: On the Invitation to Bid the cutoff date for questions from Vendors was listed as Thursday, February 19, 2021 at 4:30 p.m. Of course, that was a typographical error as February 19, is today which is Friday. A question was asked and received by WCS this morning from one of the Vendors. Because WCS had made the error on the date we will be answering this question. All 3 vendors will receive the question and the answer as noted below.

THE ACTUAL QUESTION AND THE ANSWERS ARE PROVIDED BELOW:

Vendors States: I have two questions to submit:

1. Being that Summit High School and Williamson County Schools Data Center are to share the responsibility for the WAN aggregation to ingress/egress the Internet, would the district prefer Summit High School's [Speed/Capacity Maximum] field value be changed to "20 Gbps" to match the [Speed/Capacity Maximum] field value for Williamson County Schools Data Center?

Williamson County Schools Data Center	10 Gbps	20 Gbps

2. Would the district accept 2x10 GbE circuits and handoffs at Summit High School and Williamson County Schools Data Center for the Internet access or will you require single, 100 GbE circuits and handoffs, set at a CIR of 20 Gbps each?

WCS RESPONSE TO ABOVE QUESTIONS:

Summit High can be changed to 20GB Speed Capacity Maximum. Also, quantity 2 10GB circuits are acceptable for Data Center and Summit High Internet Access.
