Williamson County Schools (WCS) Owner, is currently accepting sealed bids from licensed and qualified contractors interested in bidding on the pedestrian signal and crosswalk at the intersection connecting Page Middle School and Page High School. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope, mailed or hand delivered to WCS Central Office, 1320 West Main Street, Suite 202, Franklin, TN 37064, Attn: Joan Breeding. Faxed or emailed bids will not be accepted. Sealed bids will be received until 10:30 a.m. on Thursday, May 27, 2021 at which time they will be publicly opened. Any bid received after the specified opening time will not be accepted. In the event WCS must reschedule a RFB opening date or time, the specifications obtained from the Purchasing Dept. shall reflect the actual date and time. Once the sealed bid envelope is submitted to WCS the Purchasing Department will stamp the face of the envelope to authenticate the actual date and time it is received.

A pre-bid meeting will be conducted on Tuesday, May 18, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. at Page Middle School, 6262 Arno Rd, Franklin, TN 37064. Although the pre-bid meeting is not mandatory it is highly encouraged as important information concerning the bid project will be discussed. Visitors must check in at the school office.

- Bid bond in the amount of 5% of the total bid. The bond is required as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted, a contract will be entered into. Refer to bid documents for complete instructions.

NOTE: All of the above items are required. If any are not included, the bid will not be opened or accepted.

Prime bidders (a prime bidder is one who registers for plans with the office) shall obtain plans and other documents from the office of Design Consultants, Inc. (DCI), 2207 Crestmoor Road, Suite 101, Nashville, TN 37215 Attn: Kenneth L. Ellzy, Vice President (615-400-8410).

All contractors must be licensed under the provisions of the current Contractor's Licensing Act of Tennessee and shall be thoroughly familiar with all the provisions of said act. Contracts for this project will be awarded to the best, lowest and most responsive bid that successfully passes the bid/qualification process. Design Consultants, Inc. will assist in the review and bid tabulations and will provide to WCS a written recommendation as to the awarded bidder. Once the successful bidder has been established through the competitive bid process and Design Consultants, Inc. will make a formal recommendation to WCS, then the WCS Purchasing Manager will notify the awarded bidder of our intent to proceed with the documented PO award. The encumbered award PO will also give reference to the Notice to Proceed Instructions. The date of the fully funded-encumbered award PO issued by WCS Purchasing Department shall be approximately 10 days after the bid opening. Bidders are to include all sales and use tax, payroll tax, insurance, bonds, etc. as

applicable by State of TN procurement laws.

Awarded bidder must provide to WCS the following items within fifteen (15) consecutive calendar days from the date of WCS award notice:

- Fully executed AlA contract (facilitated through Design Consultants, Inc.)
- A Payment, Performance, Labor and Materials (PPLM) Bond in the amount of 100% of the contract sum, issued by a bonding company licensed to do business in the state of Tennessee and acceptable to the Owner. Bond is required of the successful bidder to guarantee faithful performance of work under the contract.
- In the event the successful Bidder to whom the contract is awarded fails to execute a satisfactory contract and PPLM bond and proof of insurance then said bidder shall be eliminated and shall forfeit his 5% bid bond and be liable for any loss occasioned to the Owner because of such failure.
- Insurance: WCS must be named as an additional insured on contractor's policy as follows: Contractor will obtain and maintain insurance to protect the contractor and owner from claims which may arise out of or result from contractor's operations under the contract. Certificate of Liability with a minimum of \$2,000,000 listing WCS as additional insured must be provided.
