Once the sealed bid envelope is submitted to WCS, the Purchasing Department will stamp the face of the envelope to authenticate the actual date and time it is received.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at 3:30 p.m. on Monday, March 21, 2022 at Centennial High School, 5050 Mallory Ln, Franklin, TN, 37067. Although attendance to the pre-bid meeting is not mandatory, it is highly encouraged as important information concerning the bid project will be discussed. Attendees should meet outside in back of the school at the boiler room, near the loading dock and cooling tower.
