Faxed or emailed bids will **not** be accepted. Any bid received after the specified opening time will **not** be accepted. In the event WCS must reschedule a RFB opening date or time, the specifications obtained from the WCS Purchasing Dept. shall reflect the actual date and time. Once the sealed bid envelope is submitted to WCS, the Purchasing Department will stamp the face of the envelope to authenticate the actual date and time it is received.
