## Water Heater Replacements at Fairview Elementary School, Fairview Middle School and Ravenwood High School

Williamson County Schools, (WCS) is currently accepting sealed bids from qualified contractors for water heater replacement at Fairview ES, Fairview MS, and Ravenwood HS. Sealed bids will be received until 10:30 am on Thursday, December 15, 2022, at which time they will be publicly opened. Faxed or emailed bids will not be accepted. Any bid received after the specified opening time will not be accepted. - Bid bond in the amount of 5%. This bond is required as a guarantee that it if accepted, a contract will be entered into. Refer to bid documents for complete bidding instructions.

An apparent low Bidder will be established from this bid process. Contracts for this project will be awarded to the lowest, best, and most responsive bid that reasonably meets the specifications and qualifications. WCS Purchasing will prepare a bid tabulation shortly after the bid opening. The WCS Maintenance & Purchasing Department along with Ben Hunter of Entech Engineering will review all the accepted bid submissions and bid tabulations. Once the apparent low bidder has been established through the competitive bid process, Entech Engineering will provide to WCS a written (documented) recommendation of who the bid should be awarded to. WCS Purchasing will then release the bid tabulations noting the apparent low bidder to all participants of the bid with our intent to award. Approximately twenty (20) consecutive calendar days after the bid tabulations are released (due to the holidays and closures in December), WCS will issue a fully funded award PO to the winning bidder.

After the successful bidder has received the award notice/purchase order, said bidder <u>must provide</u> to WCS the following items within (15) consecutive calendar days from the date of WCS award notice:

- Fully executed AIA contract (facilitated through Entech Engineering, Inc.)
- A Payment, Performance, Labor, and Materials (PPLM) Bond in the amount of 100% of the contract sum, issued by a bonding company licensed to do business in the state of Tennessee and acceptable to the Owner. Bond is required of the successful bidder to guarantee faithful performance of work under the contract.
- In the event the successful Bidder to whom the contract is awarded fails to execute a satisfactory contract and PPLM bond and proof of insurance then said bidder shall be eliminated and shall forfeit his 5% bid bond and be liable for any loss occasioned to the Owner because of such failure.
- INSURANCE: WCS must be named as an additional insured on contractor's policy.
  - A. Contractor will obtain and maintain insurance to protect contractor and Owner from claims which may arise out of or result from contractor's operations under the contract. Certificate of Liability with a minimum of \$2,000,000 listing WCS as additional insured must be provided.
