Gentlemen:

The undersigned, as Bidder, hereby declares that the only person, or persons interested in this Bid as principal, or principals, is or are named herein and that this Bid is in all respects fair and in good faith without collusion or fraud.

The Bidder further declares that he has examined the site of the Work and informed himself fully in regard to all conditions thereon and has examined the Drawings, Specifications, and Contractual Documents for the Work and has satisfied himself relative to the Work to be performed.

The Bidder further agrees that he will not withdraw this Bid within a period of Forty-Five (45) consecutive calendar days from and including the date of this Bid and that, if this Bid is accepted, he will execute a Contract within said Forty-Five (45) day period and within ten (10) consecutive calendar days after date of written notice of such acceptance. In case of failure on the Bidder's part to perform as agreed above, the monies payable on the Bid Bond accompanying this Bid shall be paid into the funds of the Owner as liquidated damages for such failure; otherwise, the Bid Bond shall be returned to the Bidder.

The Bidder further agrees that prices established in this Bid shall extend for a duration of one year from date the contract is executed. Upon mutual agreement by Owner and Contractor, the duration may be extended for a second, third, fourth and fifth one (1) year period, and a price (per unit) increase will be negotiated which shall not exceed 2% per year. This bid shall not exceed a total of five (5) years.

The Bidder further proposes and agrees to contract with the Owner on the 2017 Edition of AIA Document A105, *Standard Short Form of Agreement between Owner and Contractor*. In addition, Bidder proposes and agrees to furnish for the following sum all necessary materials, equipment, tools, apparatus, means of transportation and labor necessary to complete the construction of the Project in complete accordance with the shown, noted, described, and reasonable intended requirements of Drawings, Specifications, and Contract Documents, with the definite understanding that no money will be allowed for extra work except as set forth in the Contractual Documents.

In submitting this bid, Bidder is certifying that he is aware of the requirements imposed by T.C.A. § 49-5-413(d) to conduct criminal background checks through the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation and the Federal Bureau of Investigation on himself and any of his employees, who may come into direct contact with students or who may come on or about school property, any time students are present. Bidder is certifying that at no time will he ever permit any individual, who has committed a sexual offense or who is a registered sex offender, to come into direct contact with children or to come on or about school property while students are present.

The Bidder further agrees that he and each subcontractor employing no less than five (5) employees will execute and submit to the Owner the attached DRUG FREE WORKPLACE AFFIDAVIT. No contractor or subcontractor may perform work on this project unless this form is fully executed and submitted prior to the start of the project. The General Contractor shall submit a fully executed, notarized copy of this form with this bid.

UNIT PRICE BIDS

Unit prices include all costs associated with the work, including, but not limited to, travel, recycling, shop supplies, wire nuts / washers, sockets, fuses, etc.

The following unit price Bids shall be utilized to compute compensation due the Contractor. The quantities noted on this bid are estimates used for bid comparison only and will vary from actual quantities provided. The minimum value of work ordered per project shall be \$1,000.00. In the event the quantity of work ordered for an individual project should be valued less than \$1,000.00, this minimum cost shall apply. Labor cost billed for unit pricing is to be time on site. Travel time is not to be billed.

NON-BOYCOTT OF ISRAEL CERTIFICATION

Tenn. Code Ann. § 12-4-119 prohibits public entities from entering into a contract for services, supplies, information technology or construction unless the contract includes a written certification that the company is not currently engaged in and will not be engaged in for the duration of the contract, a boycott of Israel. This applies to any contract entered into on or after July 1, 2022. The law does not apply to contracts with a value of less than \$250,000 or in contracts where the supplier has less than ten employees. A boycott of Israel means engaging in refusals to deal, terminating business activities or other commercial actions that are intended to limit commercial relations with Israel, or companies doing business in or with Israel or authorized by, licensed by or organized under the laws of the State of Israel to do business, or persons or entities doing business in Israel, when such actions are taken: (1) In compliance with, or adherence to, calls for a boycott of Israel, or (2) In a manner that discriminates on the basis of nationality, national origin, religion, or other unreasonable basis and is not based on a valid business reason. Tenn. Code Ann. § 12-4-119.

CERTIFICATION: The Contractor certifies that it is not currently engaged in, and will not for the duration of the contract engage in, a boycott of Israel as defined by Tenn. Code Ann. § 12-4-119.
