Heritage Middle, Page Middle, Fairview HS and
Maintenance/Service Compound Transportation Lots**

IMPORTANT NOTE:

In both advertisements which appeared on Feb. 20, 2025 in the Tennessean and the Williamson Herald, the locations listed included Hillsboro K-8 and omitted FvHS this was a mistake.

The correct location should be Heritage Middle and Fairview High has also been added to the list above. Also, for clarification the (service compound) is our Maintenance/Service Compound Transportation Lots.

Williamson County Schools, (WCS) is currently accepting sealed bids from qualified paving contractors interested in bidding on paving repairs and replacements projects for Bethesda, Scales, Walnut Grove, Heritage Middle, Page Middle and WCS Service Compound.

Sealed Bid envelopes will be accepted at the WCS Central Office, 1320 West Main Street, Suite 202, Franklin, TN 37064, until **2:30 p.m. on Thursday, March 27, 2025**, at which time they will be publicly opened.

Bids must be delivered by express mail or hand delivered to the attention of Skip Decker. All bids will be stamped by the Purchasing Department with the date and time of receipt to ensure compliance. Any bid envelope received after the specified opening time will **not** be accepted. Faxed or emailed bids will **not** be accepted.

Bid envelopes shall be marked **“RFB #1363 Pavement Repairs and Replacements”**.

A pre-bid meeting will be held beginning at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, March 13, 2025, located at Bethesda Elementary, 4907 Bethesda Road, Thompson Station, TN 37179.

Although attendance at the pre-bid meeting is not mandatory it is highly encouraged as valuable information concerning the bid project will be discussed.

The following information must be listed on the outside of the sealed bid envelopes:

- RFB #1363 Pavement Repair and Replacement
- Contractor's Name & Address
- Date and Time of Bid opening,
- Tennessee Contractor License #, Classification, Expiration Date & Limitations.
- List of all Subcontractor's and their Tennessee Contractor License #,
- Classification, Expiration, Date & License Limitations regardless of amounts

Interested General Contractors must include in their sealed bid envelope the following:

- Contractor's Qualification Statement
- Non-Collusion Affidavit of Prime Contractor
- Certification of Bidder Regarding Equal Employment Opportunity
- Drug Free Affidavit
- Criminal Background Affidavit
- Certificate of Compliance with Tennessee Licensing Law
- Iran Divestment Act
- Non-Boycott of Israel Affidavit
- Signed Bid Form and a 5% Bid Bond

All contractors must be licensed under the provisions of the current contractor's licensing Act of Tennessee and shall be thoroughly familiar with all the provisions of said act. All Bidders must comply with Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 62, in particular Chapter 6 regarding preparation of the bid envelope, in particular giving his name address, license number, license expiration date, the part of the classification of the license applying to the bid and the license dollar limitation and shall mark the project bid for project name location of project and the date and time of the bid opening.

All contractors proposing to submit a bid shall obtain a specification book and bid book from the consultant for their bid to be accepted. This will also place the contractor on the approved list of bidders for possible addenda issuance. Documents will be available from Collier Engineering beginning March 6, 2025. Contracts for this project will be awarded to the lowest, best, and most responsive bid that reasonably meets specifications and qualifications. WCS Purchasing will prepare a bid tabulation shortly after the bid opening. The WCS Maintenance and Purchasing Department along with Matt Campbell of Collier Engineering will review the bid tabulations. Once the apparent low bidder has been established through the competitive bid process, Collier Engineering will provide WCS a written (documented) recommendation of who the winning bid should be awarded to. The WCS Purchasing Department will release an intent to award naming the lowest bidder by sending a copy to all participants of the bid. Approximately ten (10) consecutive calendar days after the tabulations are released WCS will issue a fully funded award PO to the low bidder.

After the successful bidder has received the Award Notice / Purchase Order, said bidder must provide WCS with the following items within (15) consecutive calendar days from the date of WCS award notice:

- Fully executed Large Project Unit Price Construction Contract facilitated through Collier Engineering – Matt Campbell
- Awarded Bidder only shall provide a Payment, Performance, Labor, and Materials (PPLM) Bond in the full amount of the PO issued by a bonding company licensed to do business in the state of Tennessee and acceptable to the Owner. Bond is required of the successful bidder to guarantee faithful performance of work under the contract.
- In the event the successful Bidder to whom the contract is awarded fails to execute a satisfactory contract and PPLM bond and proof of insurance – then said bidder shall be eliminated and WCS will begin negotiations with the next best bidder.
- INSURANCE: WCS must be named as an additional insured on contractor's policy.
A. Contractor will obtain and maintain insurance to protect contractor and owner from claims which may arise out of or result from contractor's operations under the contract. Certificate of Liability with a minimum of \$2,000,000 listing WCS as additional insured must be provided.

- Award PO released to winning bidderapproximately 10 consecutive calendar days after the name of the apparent low bidder is released.
- No bidder may withdraw his bid within 60 consecutive calendar days after the actual date of the public bid opening Thursday, March 27, 2025 at 2:30 p.m.
- Bidders are to include all sales and use tax, payroll tax, insurance, bonds, etc. as applicable by State of TN procurement laws.
- Nothing contained in the commissioned engineer's RFB documents or amendments thereto shall eliminate or reduce the requirements contained in the legal advertisement or this invitation to bid.
- NOTE: All WCS RFB's are ultimately subject to funding. Furthermore, WCS reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject any or all bids that are not in the best interest of WCS.
