Once the sealed bid envelope is submitted to WCS, the Purchasing Department will stamp the face of the envelope to authenticate the actual date and time it is received.

Pre-bid information will also be listed on the WCS website. Although attendance at the pre-bid meeting is not mandatory, it is highly encouraged, as valuable information concerning the bid project will be discussed.
