RFB #1420 DISTRICT VEHICLES & MOTORIZED EQUIPMENT

Williamson County Schools (WCS) is accepting sealed bids from qualified dealers interested in bidding on vehicles and motorized equipment for the district. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope, and mailed or hand delivered to WCS, Central Office, 1320 West Main Street, Suite 202, Franklin, TN 37064, Attn: Amanda Waycaster. Faxed or emailed bids will not be accepted.

Sealed bid envelopes will be received until Tuesday, September 29, 2026, 2:30 p.m. at which time they will be officially opened. Any bids received after the specified opening time cannot be accepted. Once the sealed bid envelope is submitted to WCS, the Purchasing Department will stamp the face of the envelope to authenticate the actual date and time it is received. Bidders must mark sealed bid envelopes **“WCS RFB #1420 District Vehicles & Motorized Equipment.”** In the event WCS must reschedule a bid opening date or time, the specifications obtained from the WCS Purchasing Department shall reflect the actual date and time.

The following items must be listed on the outside of the sealed bid envelope:

- WCS RFB #1420 District Vehicles & Motorized Equipment
- Date and Time of Bid Opening
- Vehicle or Equipment Dealer Name and Address

The following items must be included inside the sealed bid envelope:

- Certification of Compliance with the Iran Divestment Act (TCA 12-12-101)
- Certification of Non-Boycott of Israel (TCA 12-4-119)
- Completed Bid Form, signed and dated, followed by items (1-10) bid sheets
- Specifications or bid specs the bidder wishes to include must be submitted with the sealed bid. Supporting specifications are limited to one (1) page per vehicle.

Williamson County Schools reserves the right to accept or reject bids, based upon the evidence (or determined by WCS Staff) before or after the bid opening, that a bidder is not necessarily qualified by experience, is not in a position to perform the work specified in the time allotted, upon evidence of collusion with intent to defraud or other illegal practice or that the item or equipment submitted for bid does not meet the desired WCS specifications as determined by WCS staff.

SECTION I – GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Bids must be completed in full and submitted in accordance with the requirements and specifications of this solicitation. WCS reserves the right to reject any bid that is incomplete, contains material irregularities, or fails to comply with the solicitation requirements. WCS may, at its sole discretion, request clarifications or corrections as permitted by applicable procurement policies and regulations.
2. WCS reserves the right to award multiple vendors at its sole discretion. For this bid project, WCS seeks to purchase two (2) box trucks, one (1) bucket truck, one (1) dump truck, two (2) high roof cargo van, two (2) medium roof cargo vans, two or three (2 or 3) extended or double cab pickup trucks, one (1) three-quarter ton 4x4 pickup truck, one (1) three-quarter ton pickup with hydraulic liftgate, one (1) utility service truck, and two (2) utility work trucks. All awards will be based on current funding. These vehicles and motorized equipment may be different make or model. However, they must reasonably meet or exceed all the bid specifications herein. Award Purchases will be made depending on price and availability and may result in the purchases being made from the same or different vendors.
3. Unless noted, bid is not limited or restricted to any specific manufacturer, brand name, model or make. The use of the name of a manufacturer or any special brand name, model or make in describing an item or the use of detailed descriptive specifications pertinent thereto, does not restrict bidders to that manufacturer or specific article or such detailed descriptive specifications. As previously stated, this method is simply being used to indicate the character or quality of the desired article. All items bid however, must be of such character, quality and design as will serve the purpose for which it is intended to be used equally as well as that specified, and be equally suitable to the needs of Williamson County Schools.
4. When proposing a vehicle that differs from the make, model, or brand specified, the bidder shall provide the manufacturer's name, model information, specifications, catalog references, and any other information necessary to evaluate the proposed alternative. Such information must be clearly identified on the RFB cover sheet. Williamson County Schools, through the Purchasing Department, shall be the sole judge in determining the acceptability and suitability of any proposed alternative.
5. **Funding and Taxes:** Award of this solicitation is contingent upon the availability of funding. Williamson County Schools is a tax-exempt entity. Any applicable sales tax, use tax, delivery charges, preparation fees, or other pass-through costs that are not exempt shall be the responsibility of the awarded vendor and must be included in the bid price. All costs associated with furnishing and delivering the vehicles shall be reflected in the total bid amount.
6. Quantities stated in this solicitation are approximate and are provided for bid evaluation purposes only. They represent WCS's best estimate of anticipated requirements and shall not be construed as a guarantee of purchase. WCS reserves the right to increase or decrease quantities and to purchase based on actual needs, funding availability, and operational requirements.

7. Bid pricing and terms shall remain firm and binding for a minimum of sixty (60) calendar days following the bid opening date or until contract award, whichever occurs first. Upon award, the successful bidder(s) shall honor all awarded pricing, terms, and conditions for a period of ten (10) months from the bid opening date. Williamson County Schools reserves the right to purchase awarded vehicles and/or equipment at the awarded prices at any time during this ten (10) month period.
8. Back orders are discouraged. WCS will not accept invoices or make payment for partial shipments. Payment will be processed only upon complete delivery of all items covered by the purchase order.
9. All available dealer or manufacturer incentives, rebates, cash allowances, and promotional discounts shall be incorporated into the bidder's proposed pricing. The awarded vendor shall be solely responsible for filing, claiming, and processing any such incentives or discounts. WCS shall not be responsible for completing paperwork, submitting claims, or otherwise participating in incentive programs.
10. If vehicle options listed have been unintentionally omitted that require future purchase, the awarded bidder should extend a comparable discount for such items. These items may be negotiated with the awarded bidder. WCS reserves the right to cancel any PO with written notice within 20 days. The Williamson County Schools Purchasing Department must approve any change in offers to the original bid specifications.
11. The language of this RFB shall be binding unless mutually amended by WCS and the awarded bidder. Issuance of a WCS purchase order will be considered as the award notice. The terms and conditions of this RFB and detailed purchase order shall constitute the entire agreement. It is the intent of WCS to make awards to the lowest and best bids that are most responsive and most meets or exceeds the specifications as determined by WCS.
12. Because WCS cannot anticipate or specify every detail of the required vehicle or motorized equipment, bidders shall comply with the intent of the specifications and shall not take advantage of any errors or omissions. Bidders must provide vehicles or equipment that meet or exceed WCS requirements.
13. All invoices must reference a valid WCS purchase order number. WCS requires one itemized invoice per purchase order, submitted only after complete delivery of all vehicles on the purchase order and acceptance by the Purchasing Department. WCS will not make prepayments or partial payments.
14. Invoices must be consistent with the awarded bid pricing. WCS shall not be responsible for any additional charges not included in the bidder's proposal. Bidders are expected to submit their most competitive all-inclusive pricing. All prices shall include delivery to the WCS Central Office, and the awarded bidder shall be responsible for all delivery arrangements. Vehicles shall not be delivered to any location other than the WCS Central Office unless otherwise authorized by the Purchasing Department.

15. The awarded vendor shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, codes, licensing requirements, and ordinances. Upon request, the vendor shall provide documentation demonstrating compliance. If the awarded vendor fails to perform its obligations under the contract, WCS reserves the right to negotiate with the next highest-ranked responsive and responsible bidder to provide the required goods or services. Such failure to perform may also be considered in the evaluation of the vendor's eligibility for future WCS solicitations and awards.
16. WCS will obtain all required license tags for the vehicles. Therefore, license tag costs shall be excluded from the bid price.
17. **Liquidated Damages:** If delivery is not completed by the delivery date stated on the bid cover sheet, liquidated damages of \$250 per calendar day shall be assessed beginning on the first day after the delivery deadline and continuing until the vehicles and/or motorized equipment are received by WCS. Liquidated damages shall be deducted from the vendor's invoice.
18. All vehicles shall be delivered to WCS no later than 180 calendar days from the date of the purchase order, unless otherwise authorized in advance.
19. **Delivery Scheduling:** All deliveries must be coordinated through the WCS Purchasing Department, not the department receiving the vehicle or motorized equipment, and must be scheduled at least 48 hours in advance. Following delivery, the awarded vendor shall submit a detailed, itemized invoice. At the time of delivery, the vendor shall provide the certificate of origin (if applicable), original window sticker, and bill of sale showing the current odometer and/or hour meter reading to the WCS Purchasing Department. The WCS Purchasing Department will coordinate inspection and invoice approval. Failure to comply with these requirements may result in payment delays.

SECTION II – OBLIGATIONS

The terms and conditions contained herein shall be incorporated into and made a part of any resulting contract. Williamson County Schools ("WCS") reserves the right to negotiate additional terms and conditions deemed necessary and in the best interest of WCS.

1. Indemnification / Hold Harmless

The awarded vendor shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Williamson County Schools, its officers, employees, agents, and representatives from and against any and all claims, demands, actions, damages, losses, liabilities, costs, and expenses, including reasonable attorney fees, arising out of or resulting from the vendor's performance, breach of contract, negligence, or the acts or omissions of the vendor, its employees, agents, subcontractors, or suppliers.

2. Delivery Schedule

Bidders shall provide the anticipated delivery date for each vehicle on the bid form. WCS reserves the right to consider delivery schedules, in addition to price, when evaluating bids and making award decisions. WCS may determine that a higher-priced bid represents the best value if the proposed delivery schedule better meets the operational needs of the school district.

3. Special Instructions for Vehicles

- All vehicles shall be delivered with a full tank of fuel.
- No vehicle will be accepted with more than 120 miles on the odometer at the time of delivery.
- The original manufacturer's suggested retail price (MSRP) window sticker shall remain intact and must accompany the delivery documents or be affixed to the vehicle at the time of delivery.

4. Bid Submission

WCS reserves the right to make awards on a line-item basis and may award to multiple vendors. Bidders are encouraged, but not required, to submit bids for all items listed in this solicitation. Bidders may bid on one or more items without penalty. Any item for which a bid is not being submitted shall be marked "N/A" on the bid form.

5. Bid Timeline

- Advertised in the Tennessean.....Tuesday, September 1, 2026
- Addendum deadline.....Wednesday, September 23, 2026, 4:30pm
- Bid Opening at WCS Central Office.....Tuesday, September 29, 2026, 2:30pm
- Bid tabs released with intent to award...approximately Friday, October 2, 2026
- Intended award announcement to winning bidder(s) approximately 10 consecutive calendar days after name of the apparent low bidder(s) and bid tabulation is released.
- Bids shall remain firm and irrevocable for 60 calendar days following the public bid opening on September 29, 2026. No bidder may withdraw its bid during this period.
- Complete delivery of all vehicles is required within 180 calendar days of the WCS purchase order date. Failure to meet the delivery date stated in the vendor's bid shall result in the assessment of liquidated damages in the amount of \$250 per calendar day. Such damages shall accrue beginning the day after the committed delivery date and continue until complete delivery is received and accepted by WCS. Liquidated damages may be deducted from any payment due to the vendor.

SECTION III – VEHICLE & MOTORIZED EQUIPMENT SPECIFICATIONS

- WCS has made every reasonable effort to include all pertinent specifications and requirements.
- Manufacturers' products vary, therefore minor differences in specifications, such as GVWR, body style, chassis, engine size, or similar features, may be acceptable. Deviations must be clearly identified on the bid form and shall not materially affect the intended use, performance, or functionality of the vehicle.
- WCS has developed these specifications to allow for a variety of manufacturers, makes, and models that can meet the district's operational requirements.
- If a proposed vehicle differs from the stated specifications beyond the acceptable ranges, bidders are encouraged to notify the Purchasing Department prior to the bid opening. If WCS determines the deviation is acceptable, an addendum may be issued to provide all bidders with the same opportunity to propose comparable alternatives.
