REGISTRATION

Registration begins March 8 - May 8, 2021

- Children of Williamson County residents, in grades kindergarten through 5th during the 2020-2021 school year, may attend the Summer SACC program.
- Children can register to attend any SACC location during the summer.
- SACC will be offered at the following elementary schools: Clovercroft, Creekside, Grassland, Lipscomb, Longview, Nolensville, Oak View, Pearre Creek, Sunset, Thompson's Station and Westwood.
- Families will need to register for each week and sign-up for the level of care needed, part-time or full-time.
- Registering for summer SACC is simple.
 - o For existing SACC families, go to parent portal located at http://www.ezchildtrack.com/sacc/parent
 - Login to your parent portal and verify the information on file.
 - Register for your weeks of camp and level of childcare that you need. Complete the summer agreement and policies.
 - For new families select new families open account. You will need to register with the SACC program, sign up for the level of care needed each week, and agree to the Summer Registration Releases.
 - A **<u>non-refundable</u>** summer registration fee of \$40 per child is due at the time of registration.
- All balances must be paid current to register for summer day camp.

WEEK TO WEEK ENROLLMENT

Families must enroll for each week individually. This allows for SACC to better meet the needs of families' summer schedules and helps ensure that sites are staffed accordingly.

Families may choose either full-time enrollment or parttime enrollment for each week their children attend.

Changes in registration can be made up to 2 weeks in advance and must be submitted online by completing a "Change of Enrollment Form" found on the SACC website.

RATES

A family is charged \$175 for each child enrolled as full-time for the week. This fee covers your child's attendance for the entire week. This fee is charged regardless of attendance.

PART-TIME ENROLLMENT

FULL-TIME ENROLLMENT

If your child is enrolled as part-time for a week, you will be charged \$40/per child for non-field trip days and \$40 per child on field trip days. If your child is enrolled as part-time, they must attend SACC at least one day during the week, or you will be charged a \$40 no-show fee per child for the week.

LAST DAY TO CANCEL AND CHANGE ENROLLMENT

All changes to enrollment must be made online by 6:00 p.m. on the date indicated below.

Deadlines are two weeks before the week of care. Changes in enrollment must be made online on the SACC website by completing a Change of Enrollment Form by the date and time listed above. Changes cannot be made on-site. Please keep a copy of the confirmation email for your records.
