WCS Classroom Cleaning and Disinfection for the 2020 - 2021 School Year

The following table provides specific information to Parents on classroom cleaning and disinfection during the COVID-19 pandemic. Teachers and Staff will have additional responsibility for spot cleaning and disinfecting their individual work areas. Custodians will be responsible for cleaning and disinfecting their normal areas, with additional high-touch disinfection, and area disinfection as directed.

	- Use and provide peroxide-based cleaning and disinfection products approved by the
Custodian Duties	CDC's "List N". Peroxide-based disinfectants are less toxic than bleach or quaternary
	ammonia products and are preferred for childcare facilities.
	- Provide and replenish cleaning/disinfecting spray product and paper towels to all
	classrooms, admin areas, and nurse offices.
	- Provide, maintain, and restock stand-alone hand sanitizer stations
	- Hourly cleaning/disinfecting restrooms and restocking soap and paper products, as
	well as disinfecting of high touch areas.
	- Daily cleaning to include sweep, spot mop, spot clean desktops, vacuum carpets,
	empty trash, nightly disinfection of desks and chairs, and hallway locker touch surfaces.
	- Daily cleaning and disinfecting of high-touch areas to include counters, sinks, water
	fountains, doorknobs/handles/plates, door frames, push bars, light switches, all
	restroom brightwork and fixtures, handrails, etc.
	- Daily perform nightly electrostatic misting disinfection of hallways, lockers, and high
	touch areas.
	-Weekly cleaning to include mop, dust, horizontal surfaces, etc.
	-As needed, clean-up spills, messes, trash, etc.
	- Teachers will be provided with approved cleaning and disinfection products for
Teachers and Staff Responsibilities	additional disinfecting during the day at their discretion.
	-Special considerations should be made for students and/or staff with asthma or other
	health issues, and they should not be present when cleaning and disinfecting is
	happening as this can trigger asthma exacerbations.
	- Upon notification of a positive COVID-19 case, areas used by the affected person will
Disinfection Protocol for a Positive COVID- 19	be closed off. School staff will assist Health Department with contact tracing.
case	- Custodians will wait 24 hours if possible before cleaning and disinfecting the affected
	areas. Once disinfected, the affected areas can be returned to service.
	- If the whole school must be disinfected, it will be closed for a minimum of 2 days.
