# Current State of Tennessee Standards for General Education Bus Riders

---

- Per Tennessee State Law, students shall not be allowed to ride the bus more than 1.5 hours to school or more than 1.5 hours from school.
- Per Tennessee State Law, students who attend their zoned school and who live more than 1.5 miles from the school are eligible for bus service.

# Current Williamson County Schools Standards for General Education Bus Riders

---

- Students residing inside subdivisions may walk up to .25 miles to the bus stop.
- WCS strives to keep the time on the bus at no more than 60 minutes to school or from school.

# Goals of Bus Hub Stop Program

---

- Reduce ride times for students on school buses.
- Allow buses to return earlier to schools for afternoon routes.

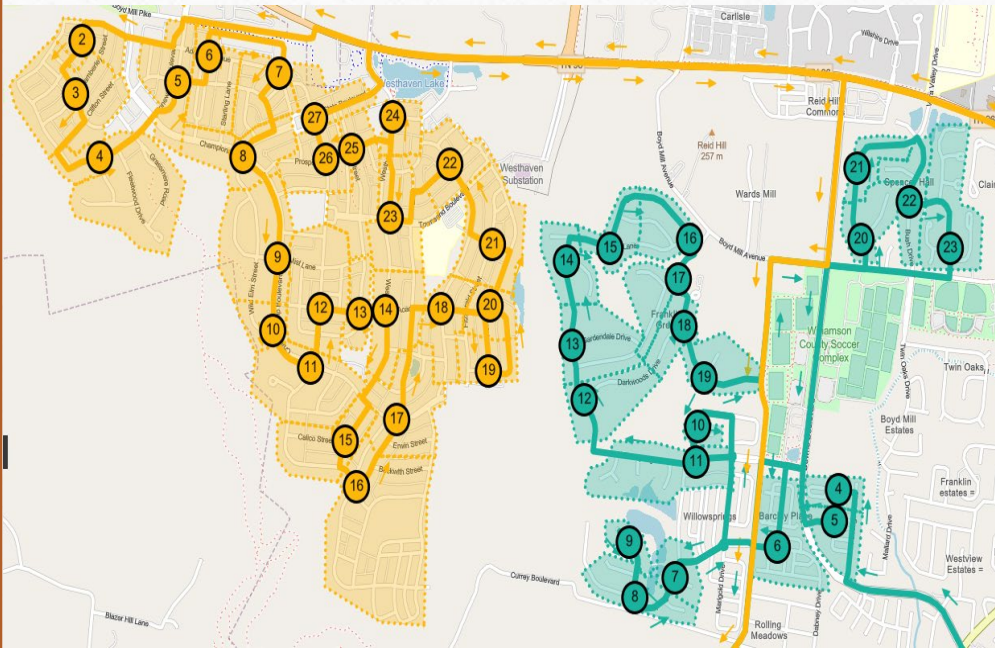
# Bus Hub Stops

---

- Bus stops are consolidated using current stop locations, playgrounds, neighborhood pools, or walking path entrances.
- Safe walkability or neighborhoods with sidewalks are considered for this program.

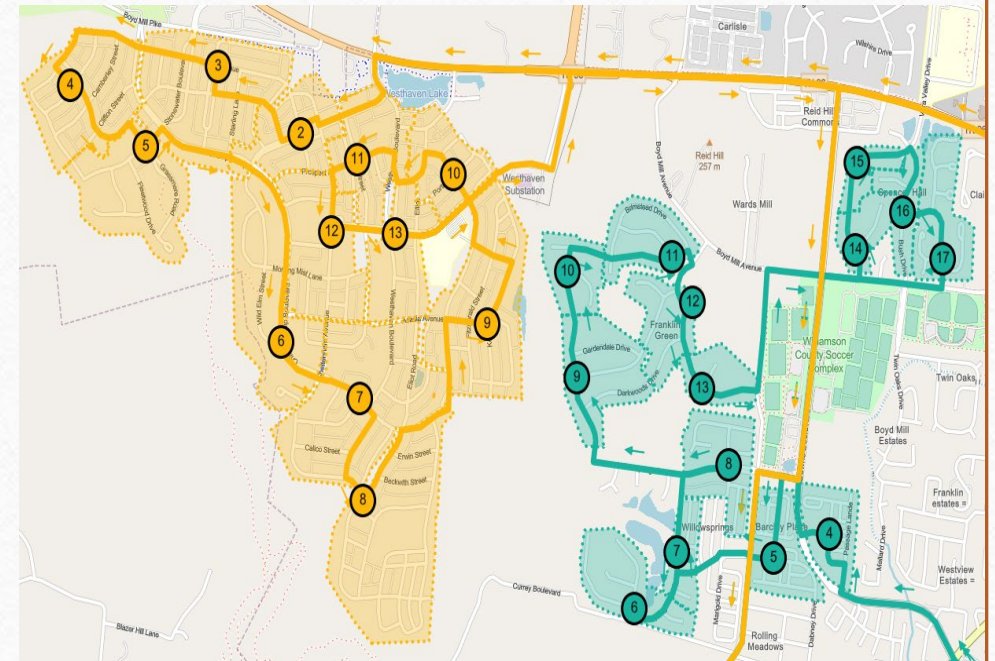
Current Routes Without Hub Stops

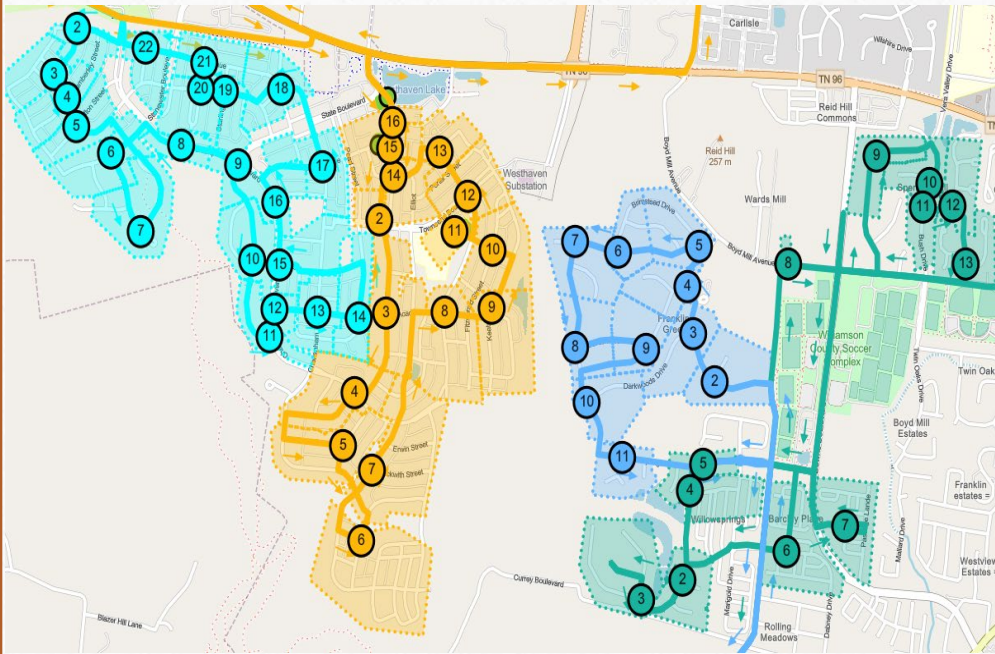

Current Routes Without Hub Stops



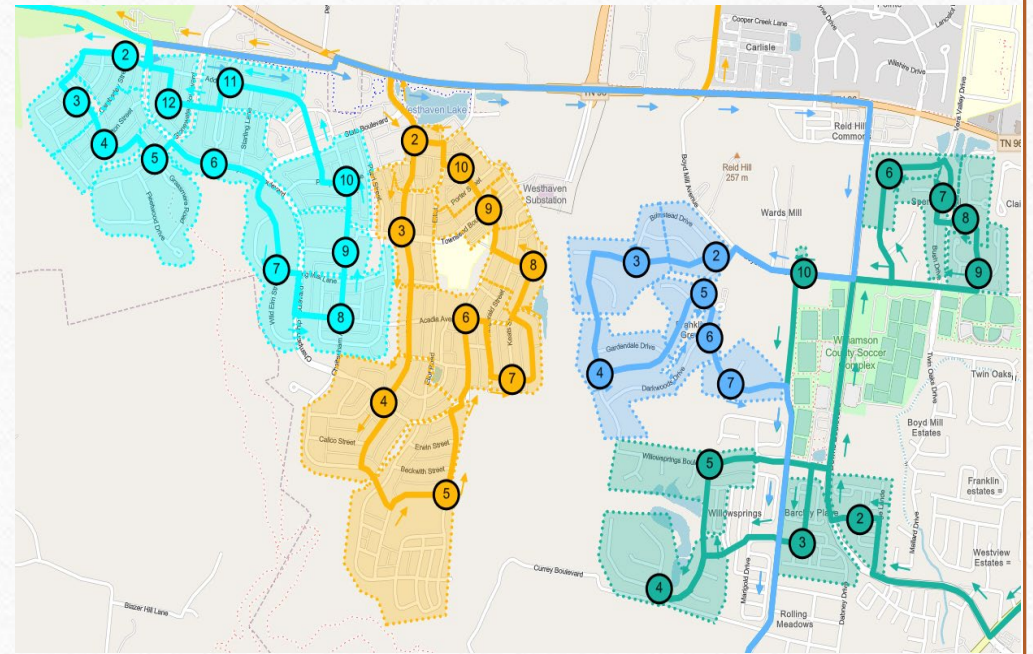

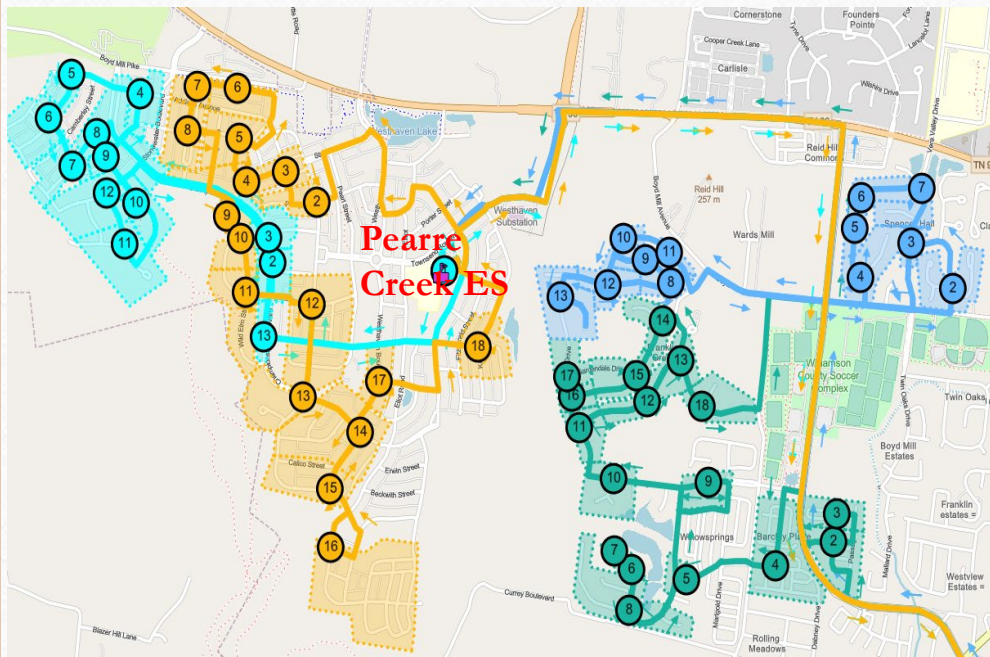

Current Routes Without Hub Stops



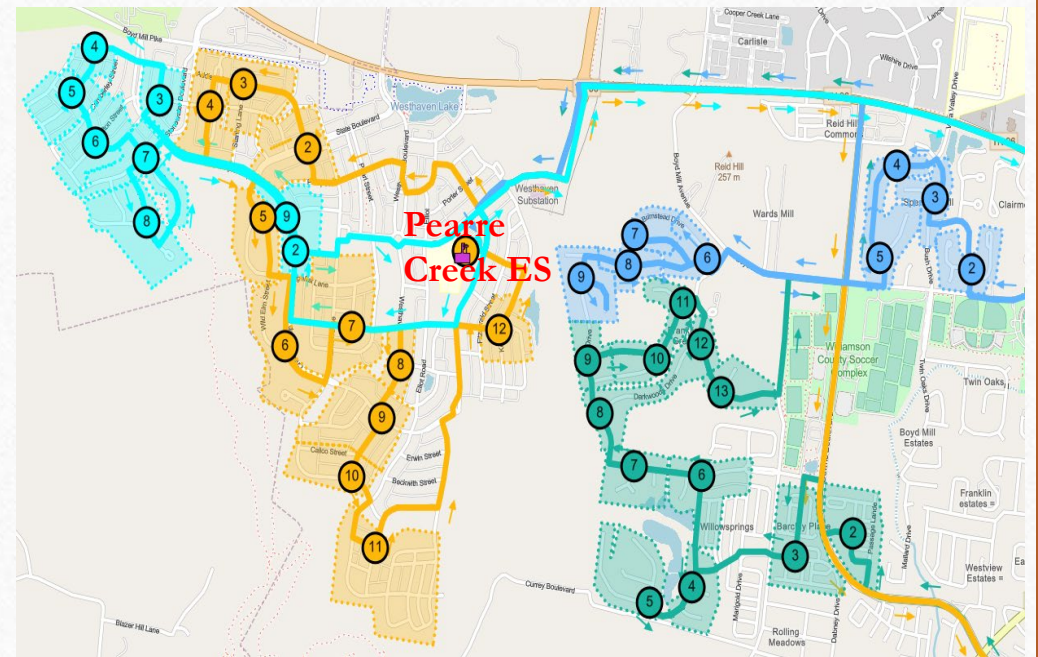
