

Current State of Tennessee Standards for General Education Bus Riders

- Per Tennessee State Law, students shall not be allowed to ride the bus more than 1.5 hours to school or more than 1.5 hours from school.
- Per Tennessee State Law, students who attend their zoned school and who live more than 1.5 miles from the school are eligible for bus service.

Current Williamson County Schools Standards for General Education Bus Riders

• Students residing inside subdivisions may walk up to .25 miles to the bus stop.

• WCS strives to keep the time on the bus at no more than 60 minutes to school or from school.

Goals of Bus Hub Stop Program

• Reduce ride times for students on school buses.

 Allow buses to return earlier to schools for afternoon routes.

Bus Hub Stops

• Bus stops are consolidated using current stop locations, playgrounds, neighborhood pools, or walking path entrances.

• Safe walkability or neighborhoods with sidewalks are considered for this program.












